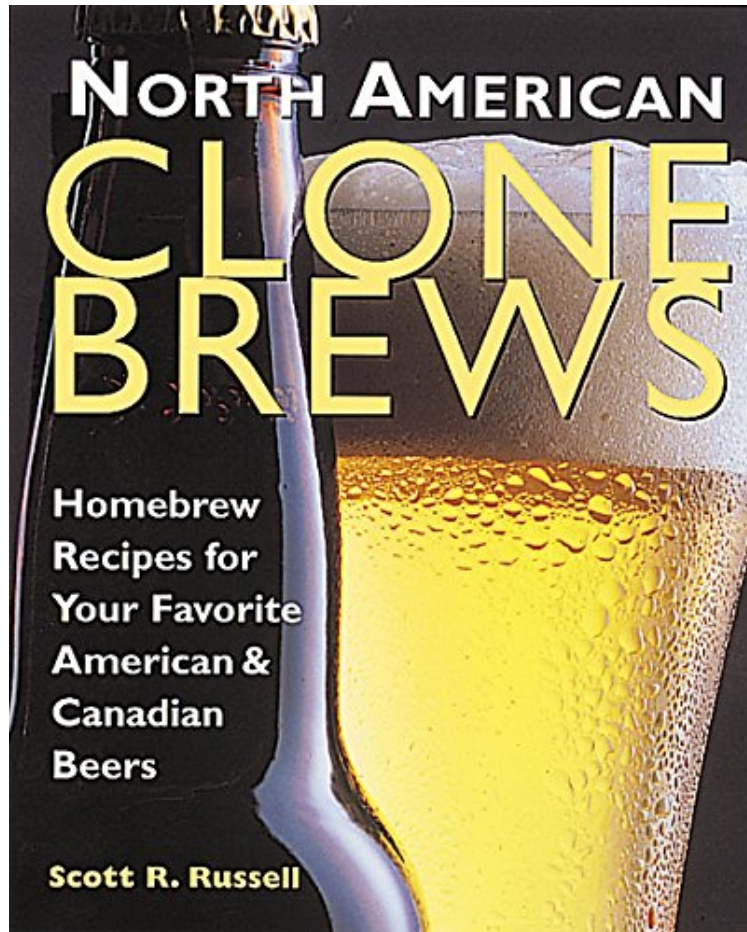

However, the book will be fine for me as a starting point for some of the recipes in it. I can make up for differences in hop utilization between extract and all-grain (I brew both at times). I can find other similar recipes and see how they compare with

those in this book and make adjustments as needed. I do agree with others that the brewer shouldn't have to do this, that the recipes should be correct, as they are in the original Clone Brews and Beer Captured books.
