Almost perfectBy Lil RuthThis is the best of the pie cookbooks that I own and will be my "go-to" source when want to try something different or have been blessed with an abundance of fruit. There are only two things that keep this book from being perfect. One is that a can of fruit pie filling is not mentioned with the rest of the ingredients in one recipe and not until after the instructions for mixing everything else together, and not everyone knows how important it is to assemble your ingredients first. The other is that just one if

the only two typos I found had me wondering if what was actually "Tblsp" was an ingredient from another country, as it now reads something like "Tcpls". The perfect parts of the book are the recipes where the cook wrote on them, which is what I do; that there are multiple variations on several types of pies; that no search for exotic ingredients will be necessary; that there are gorgeous color photographs; crediting of the origins of a recipe. There may be even more positive attributes than I have listed here. Most enjoyable is that one contributor's multiple recipes reminded me of a lady from my church who had cooking shows, first on radio, then on TV, and I still have at least one 3-ring binder as she would make an entire meal and one could then pick up a copy that had all from that week's show at Safeway. I like pie more than cake, the opposite of my mom, but Mom did teach me to pile the apples high as they would always cook down, and to sprinkle 3 Tbsp of flour (or cornstarch if you prefer) in the bottom of the crust to keep it from getting too soggy.

Pies More Pies is the first book in Jan Hinds's Not So Secret Family Recipes series to be available in print. Pies (Book 1) now includes the same recipes as Pies More Pies and are available in updates to previous ebook customers. This book contains all the recipes from the original Pies ebook plus the recipes collected by her late aunt. Many of the recipes Jan has shared were hand written or clipped and taped in the white space of favorite cookbooks. Pies More Pies has sufficient white space for you to add your family favorites within its pages. The author has included a pie crust tutorial to help even the most novice cooks become proficient pie bakers. These instructions, coupled with the easy to follow recipes will give you a new appreciation of the phrase easy as pie. Enjoy!
