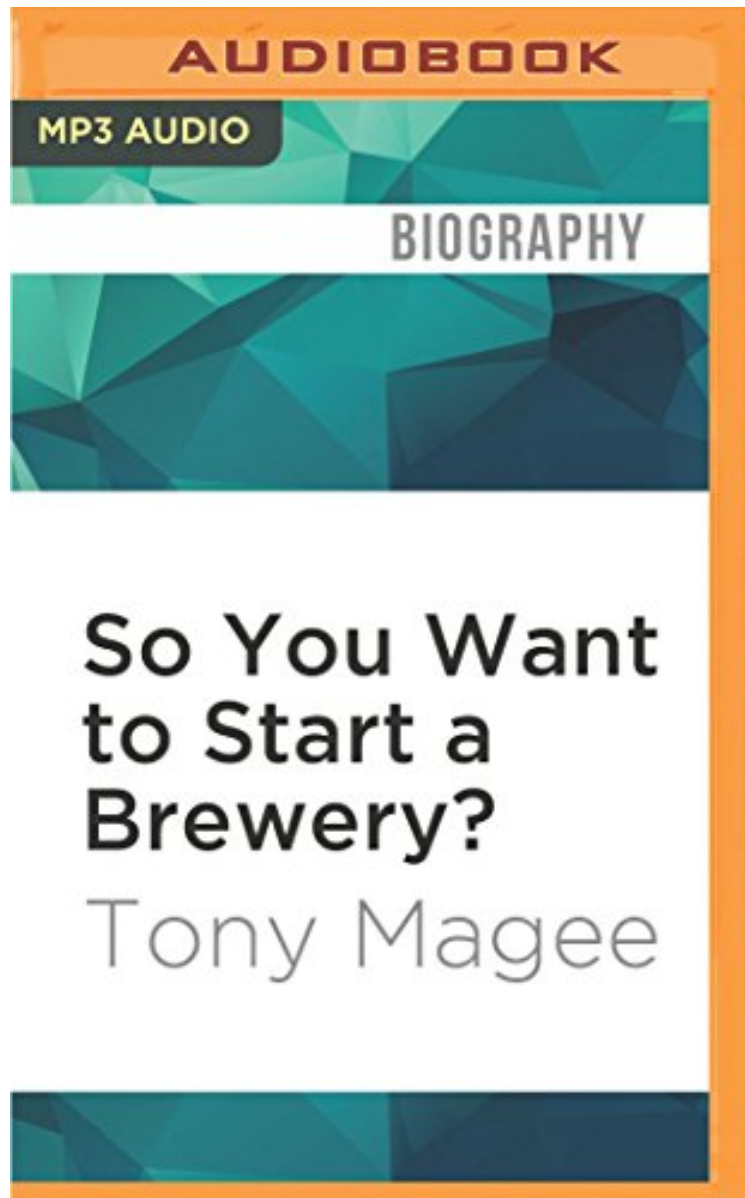

There were some great sections of the book that really pulled me in yet there were quite a few moments where I wondered what the hell am reading. There were some parts that just went way off in left field...rambling without rambling. Those chapters or sections of them lost me.
