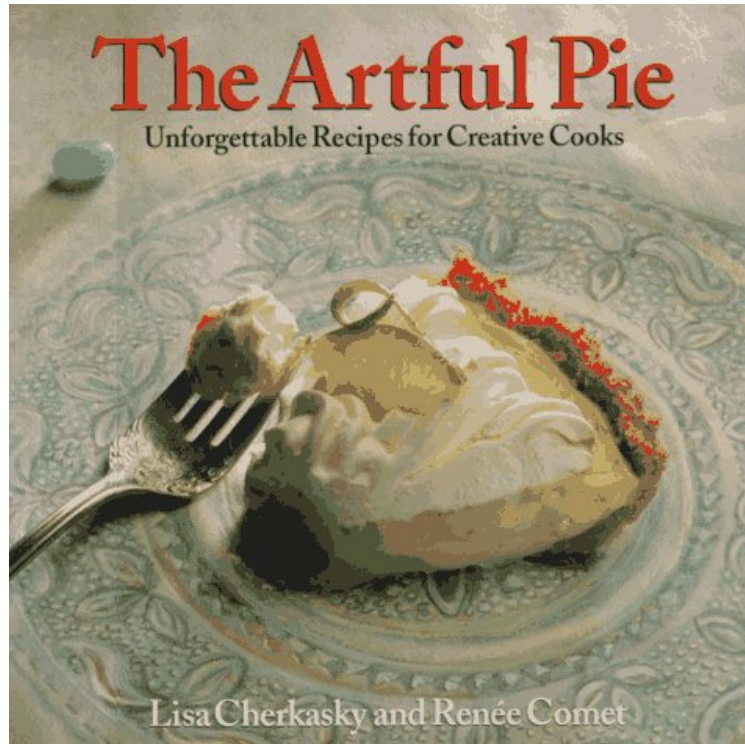

Each of the 38 pies in the book is a mixture of inspiration and convention: Cool Lime Pie with Tequila, Ultrasmooth Chocolate Malted Pie, Apple Butter Apple Pie, Butter-Brickle Banana Cream Pie. Each one has been strikingly photographed against a background of art created especially for the book.

book's 36 recipes. With Renee Comet, she commissioned 36 works of art. Then she and Comet, a food photographer, paired each pie with one of the artworks. You may enjoy the color spreads where the pies decorate or interact with the art or you can skip right to the often-original pie recipes. Some are elemental, like Fresh Peach Pie. Others are creative, but still simple, including Maple Sugar and Cream, and Upside Down Fried Pear. A few are production numbers.
